### RECAP

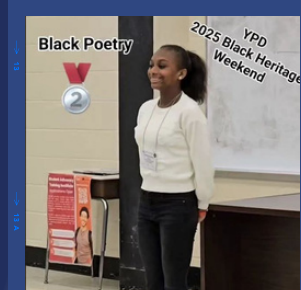
