What courses do you need to graduate?

Core classes:

English all 4 years= 4 credits

Math all 4 years = 4 credits

Science 3 years = 3 credits

Social Studies 3 years= 3 credits

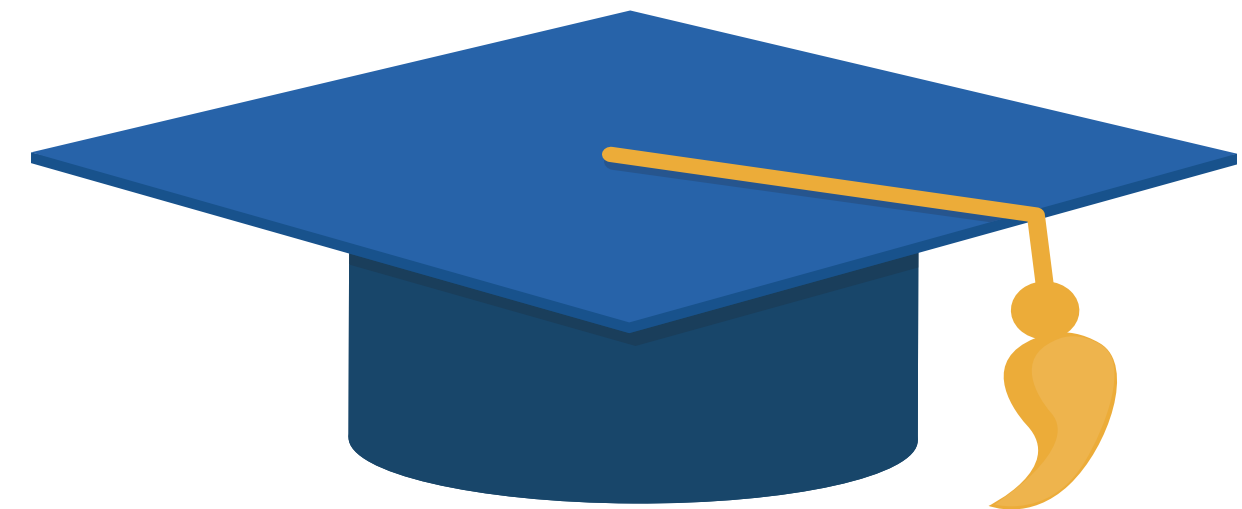
Required Electives:

PE: 1/2 PE 1/2 Personal Fitness (or 1.0 credit of HOPE)

Fine or Performing Art (1 year = 1 credit)

***Foreign Language:** A minimum of **2 years** of the same language is required for **Bright Futures Scholarship** and FL SUS **college admissions**

***Other electives:** You will take at least 8 electives throughout your 4 years of high school

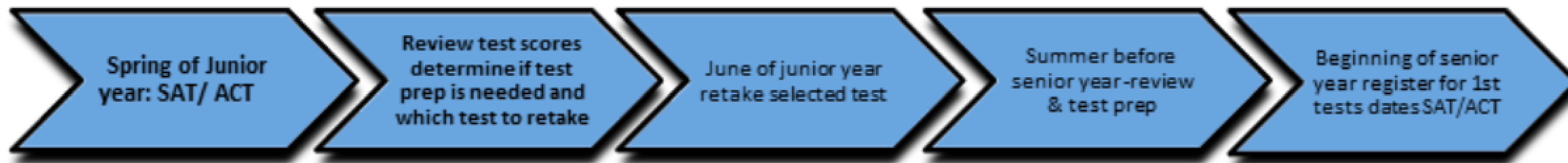

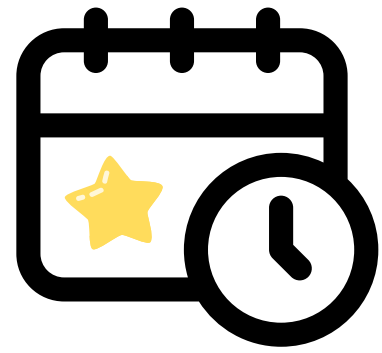
